Meeting called to order at 8:28 am

Present were Ed, Linda, Fred, Sandra, David, Lynn and Bob

Minutes of May meeting were approved

Treasurer reported a balance of \$2855.24

### **Old Business:**

1. Sandra reported that a one-minute video of Galivants Ferry has been added. Plantations, Zoos, SC Towns, and SC Gardens have been added as sub pages so far. Others will be added as needed. It was agreed that we will call the Pages "SC Photo Ops."
2. Ed reported the details of the Fall club trip that he and Fred have organized. It will include Sylvan Heights Bird Park in Scotland Neck, NC and the Statesville Balloonfest. Details and an itinerary will be distributed to the membership.
3. Linda has received registrations for the Dave Kelly Lightroom Workshop from 23 people already. Twenty are members; one is a guest of a member, and two are names I don't recognize. All but two members, who are out of the country, have given me their checks. There is no limit as of now, but it was decided that, if necessary, we would cut off participation so as to avoid overcrowding. The question came up of whether we can make a profit on this, should the participation exceed our expectations. Bob DeMarco said that we could within limits. Perhaps we're being overly optimistic!

4. Update on last meeting discussion about alternate activities for monthly meeting, Fred mentioned the possibility of having Joe Edelman present; however, his fee is \$300 for a zoom presentation. It was decided that zoom wasn't worth \$300 since past ones were \$150. Fred also proposed that Brian Osborne (thephotoclassroom.com) present at the September 12 meeting. We agreed to offer him \$300 total for a 1-hour presentation with Q&A on the topic of available/low light. NOTE: after the meeting ended, Fred was able to firm up that presentation. We still need a program for October and November. David and Linda will facilitate a critiquing session at the December meeting.
  
5. Fred reported that all existing photos from the Winyah auditorium will be taken down and new ones will be hung until further notice.

**New Business:**

1. Ed reported that Kate Silvia will be unable to do any in-person presentation this fall due to her husband's medical issues. We will explore using her on-line presentations.
