
“Dress on the Flag”

9**




I think this image is sharp and has good separation from the background. To me, the angel looks sad. The streaks below her eyes look like tears. The purple toning produces a cold appearance.



I think this image is sharp throughout and has nice lighting. In my opinion, the top two bookshelves don't add to the image. I think a square crop would make this image stronger.









I think this image has good tonality and I like the bokeh in the background. In my opinion, I think the face should be sharper and the subject a little more off centered.





One of my favorite subjects. I like how the books are arranged. They form an interesting pattern giving the background unique shape. The DOF produces a nice fade into the background.




Advanced “A Woman’s Journey of Old” 12

This image is out of focus. To me, it looks like it has been cropped, and it has lost a lot of pixels. When capturing an animal, try to get them wading into the frame.





I think this is a nice creative image. The bottle is well positioned in the frame and great colors. The orange and blue are complimentary colors. Nice Job






